Some rescue animals can be more challenging than others. We often rely on our fosters not only to provide a safe haven for our pets, but also to give them training and socialization as part of the family. (Some examples: pregnant or nursing females with puppies/kittens; scared or unsocialized dogs or cats; pets that are not yet spayed/neutered; bottle-fed kittens/puppies; dogs that may mark in the house or aren't yet house trained; dogs that are aggressive towards cat/small animals or other dogs; sick or injured animals that may require medical care.)
